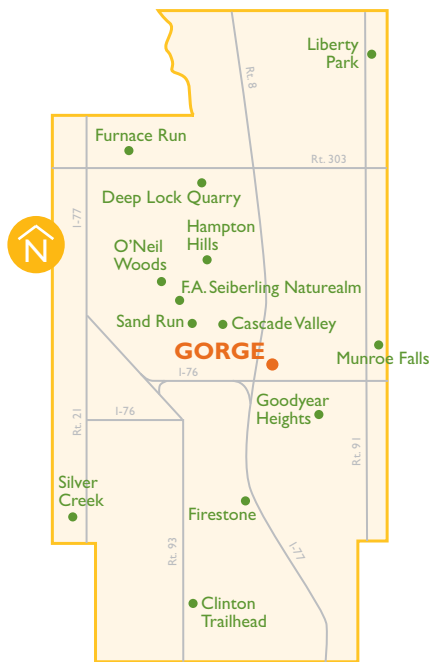




Gorge Metro Park



The beauty of a deep gorge cut by the waters of the Cuyahoga River.

The Gorge Metro Park offers beautiful riverside scenery and the facilities to enjoy it! An observation deck along the river overlooks a waterfall created by a hydroelectric dam. The park also offers a wheelchair accessible fishing dock that extends over the Cuyahoga River. Be sure to visit Mary Campbell Cave, a natural stone overhang along the riverbank that was named for a pioneer girl who was captured in Pennsylvania by Delaware Indians and brought to the cave where she lived for five years.

HOW TO GET TO Gorge Metro Park.

Gorge Metro Park is located off of Front St., North of the Cuyahoga River; in Cuyahoga Falls.

1160 Front St., Cuyahoga Falls

From State Rt. 8: Exit at Broad Blvd. in Cuyahoga Falls. Turn left (west) on Broad Blvd. and go to Front St. Turn left onto Front St. and go south approx. one mi. The park entrance will be on the right just before crossing the Cuyahoga River bridge.



Picnic Shelter

Gorge Shelter is an open-air picnic shelter which accommodates up to 64 people and is available on a first-come basis.

Winter Sports

Lighted ice skating area.
