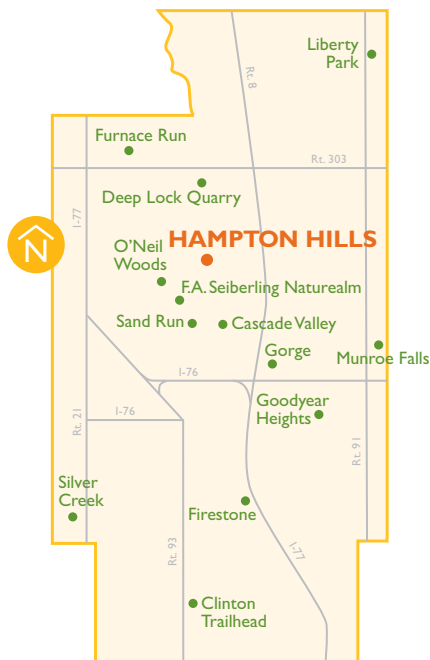




# Hampton Hills Metro Park



**Enjoy scenic vistas of the Cuyahoga Valley or traverse some of the most rugged terrain in Summit County.** Hampton Hills Metro Park offers something for everyone. You can relax and enjoy the spectacular views from the Top O' the World area on Bath Road. Or, explore ancient ravines carved by the glaciers of the last Ice Age along the Adam Run and the Spring Hollow Trails, two of the most challenging in the Metro Park system.

## HOW TO GET TO Hampton Hills Metro Park.

Hampton Hills is located off Akron-Peninsula Rd. within Akron and Cuyahoga Falls, between Steels Corners and Bath Roads.

### 2925 Akron-Peninsula Rd., Akron

**From State Rt. 8:** Exit at Steels Corners Rd. Go west on Steels Corners Rd. approx. five mi. to Akron-Peninsula Rd. Turn south on Akron-Peninsula Rd. and go 1/4 mi. to the main park entrance on the left.
