

LAKE GLACIER This 44-acre lake was built in 1904-05. Boating and fishing are permitted in season. Pedal boats and rowboats are available to rent at the Boathouse. A passenger boat is available for individual rides and group reservations. A barrier-free fishing dock is located along West Glacier Drive. Access to *Old Tree Trail* and *East Glacier Trail*.



LAKE NEWPORT This lake was built in 1928. Today it offers 60 acres of open water and 40 acres of wetlands. Boating and fishing are permitted in season. A boat launch is located on East Newport Drive. Pedal boats are available to rent at the Boathouse on West Newport Drive. Access to *West and East Channel and Islands Trails* and *West Newport Trail*.

NEWPORT WETLANDS The Newport Wetlands are situated at the southern end of Lake Newport. This area provides homes for a variety of wetland plants and animals. It is also the location of the Albert E. Davies Wetland Trail, a barrier-free .25-mile walkway that leads visitors through the wetlands to a observation deck overlooking several deep water pools.

FELLOWS RIVERSIDE GARDENS

First planted in 1963, Fellows Riverside Gardens is a public display garden that now attracts over 200,000 visitors each year. The blossoming of a bequest from Mrs. Elizabeth Fellows, the garden features a landscape of remarkable beauty with an educational backbone. Open daily, Fellows Riverside Gardens both entertains and enlightens through labeled plant displays and educational, cultural, and social activities. A variety of services are offered in the D. D. and Velma Davis Education & Visitor



Center, open Tuesday - Sunday 10 a.m. - 5 p.m. Classes and tours are available by reservation. Arrangements may also be made for weddings in the Gazebo or Kidston Pavilion, as well as receptions, meetings, or events in the Davis Center.

MILL CREEK PARK GOLF COURSE

Designed by Donald Ross, this beautiful 36-hole course is open to the public and provides a real test for the skill of even the finest golfer. The first 18 holes opened in 1928, the third nine in 1932, and the fourth nine in 1937. The Field House, built in 1929, houses a pro shop and restaurant. In the winter the Golf Course is used for cross country skiing.



JAMES L. WICK, JR. RECREATION AREA

Development of the area began in 1949, and it opened in 1956. Facilities in this 65-acre tract include a children's playground with spray pool; picnic facilities; the 18-hole Par-3 Golf Course; a fitness station; softball and baseball diamonds; sports fields; tennis, sand volleyball, and horseshoe courts; batting cages; sled riding slopes; an ice rink with warming building, skate shop, and snack bar (open December, January, and February); and a picnic pavilion available seasonally to rent. The Par 3, tennis courts, and batting cages are lighted for night use until 11 p.m. from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. Also located in this area is the Judge Morley Performing Arts Pavilion, home to the MetroParks' summer concert series.

VOLNEY ROGERS FIELD Built in 1921, this 18-acre facility offers a playground, tennis and basketball courts, softball and baseball diamonds, football fields, and a shelter house.

WALTER H. SCHOLL RECREATION AREA

Opened in 1956, this 18-acre facility offers a children's playground with spray pool, tennis and basketball courts, softball diamonds, picnic areas, and a picnic pavilion available seasonally to rent. Access to *Cascade Ravine Trail*.
