

YELLOW CREEK PARK Yellow Creek Park is located in Struthers on Lowellville Road and is leased from the City of Struthers. Operation of this lovely 76-acre gorge area of Yellow Creek was assumed by the MetroParks in 1991. The Park offers trails, a playground, tennis, horseshoe, and basketball courts, and picnic facilities. Yellow Creek Lodge is available for rental year-round and has a kitchen, fireplace, and seating for 100 people. Captain John Struthers Pavilion is available seasonally and accommodates 96 people. Yellow Creek Park facilities may be rented through the Yellow Creek Office and the Administrative Office.



METROPARKS FARM Located on Route 46 across from the Canfield Fairgrounds, this 317-acre working farm is leased from the county and operated by the MetroParks. Educational facilities consist of classrooms, a farm animal display barn, the hands-on Adventure barn, the Children's Vegetable Garden, and McMahon Hall—an all-purpose room. Available for rental year-round, McMahon Hall has a full kitchen and can accommodate from 160 people (seated at dining tables) to 250 people (seminar seating). Additional farm buildings house farm machinery, livestock, and antique farm equipment. Contact the Agricultural Programs Manager for educational opportunities and farm tour information. Tours are by appointment only. The MetroParks' Administrative Office is adjacent to the educational facilities. Access to *MetroParks Bikeway*.



McGUFFEY WILDLIFE PRESERVE

Donated to the MetroParks in 1998 by the William Holmes McGuffey Historical Society, this 78-acre retreat is located on McGuffey Road in Coitsville Township. Parking is available; hiking is permitted.



VICKERS NATURE PRESERVE This 262-acre preserve in Ellsworth Township is located just west of Canfield Township on Route 224. Acquired in 1993, the property encompasses diverse habitats such as meadowlands, woodlands,

wetlands, and ponds. Parking is available; hiking is permitted. Access to *Buckeye Horse Park Trail*.

BUCKEYE HORSE PARK The 47-acre tract adjacent to the Vickers Nature Preserve has been leased to the Buckeye Horse Park Association. This nonprofit group promotes equestrian activities and events open to the public. Direct inquiries to Horse Park Association, P.O. Box 2852, Youngstown, OH 44511.

METROPARKS BIKEWAY The MetroParks Bikeway runs from Western Reserve Road in Canfield Township to the Mahoning County/Trumbull County Line in Austintown Township. This 11-mile paved trail offers a variety of scenery for hikers, skaters, and bicyclists. Parking is available at the MetroParks Farm in Canfield Township and the Kirk Road Trailhead in Austintown Township.
