### Map Legend

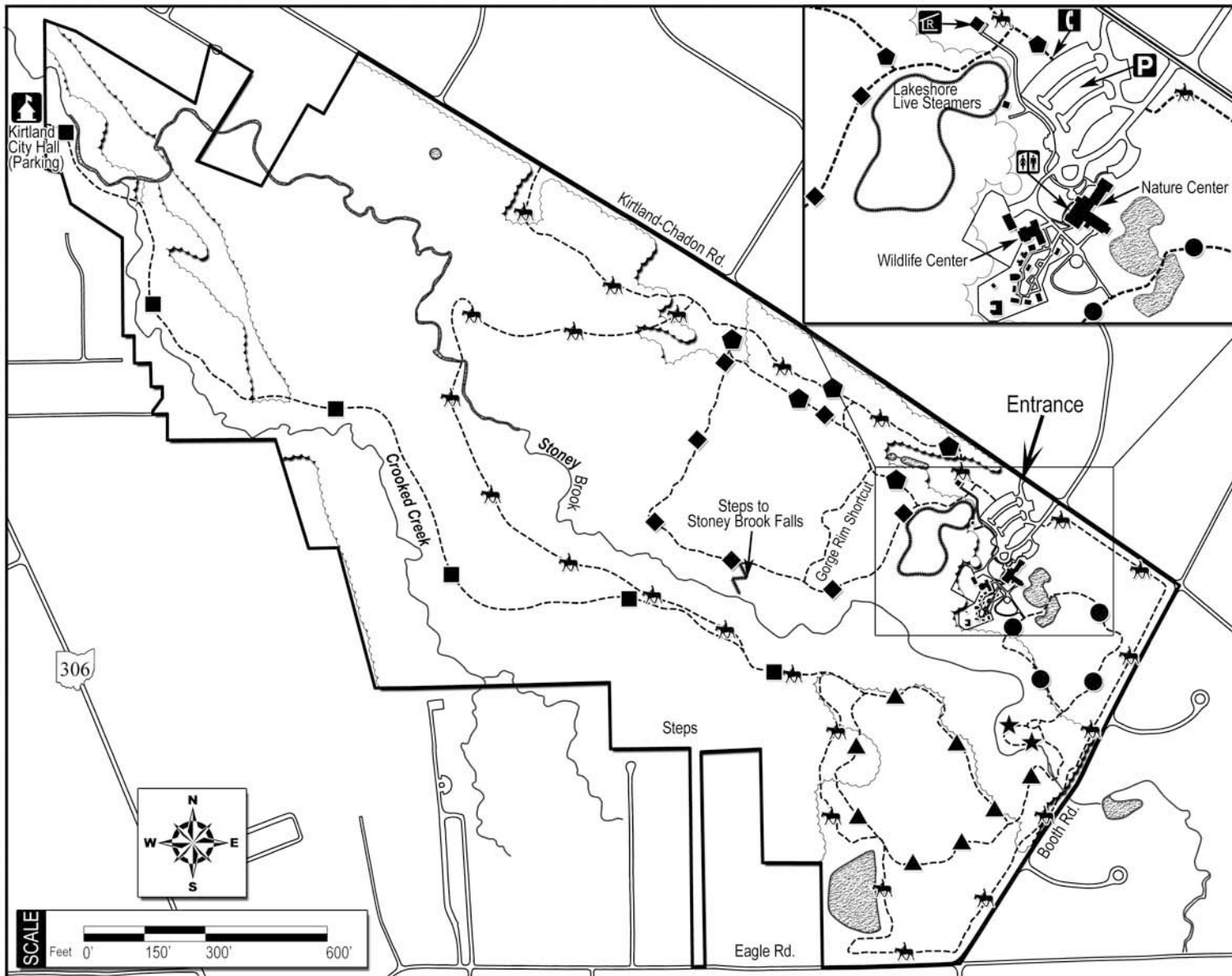

### Trail Information

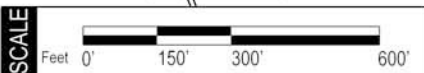
- Glen Meadow Loop**  
.5 mile, easy accessible asphalt surface with accessible gorge overlook.
- Rabbit Run Loop**  
.75 mile, easy gravel surface.
- Gorge Rim Loop**  
1 mile loop with shortcut, easy gravel surface with side trail 141 steps down into gorge.
- Bobolink Loop**  
1 mile loop, easy gravel surface with side trail to gorge overlook.
- Kirtland Connector Trail**  
1.5 miles easy gravel surface with one steep hill.
- Halle Home Loop**  
2.5 mile, dirt surface with steps.
- Bridle Trail**  
3 miles, grass and dirt surface.

### Rules to Remember

Hike on designated trails as indicated on this map.  
 Pets on a leash are welcome in the park; please clean up after them.  
 Please keep waterfowl and other animals healthy by not feeding them.  
 Fishing is permitted with a valid Ohio fishing license, catch and release is encouraged.  
 Park opens at sunrise and closes 1/2 hour after sunset.  
 The park is home to many plants and animals, do not disturb or move them.  
 Alcohol is not permitted in the park.
